

COMMUNITY RESOURCES



Time Required: 30-45 minutes

Principles:

- Students will make decisions, set goals, and take necessary action to achieve goals.

Indicators (Students will...):

- Demonstrate when, where, and how to seek help for solving problems and making decisions.

GOAL: Students will learn about resources in the community that they can turn to for support.

Activity Statements:

Students will discuss and share resources in the community that they can use to support personal and school success.

Materials:

Community Resource List

Procedures:

Teacher will distribute a list of community resources.

Students will discuss other resources not on the list that they have found useful.

Review and discuss resource list and how to use resources.

Discussion:

What resources are available to help you help someone who is depressed, suicidal?

What are some academic support services in the community?

Where would you go to for help with domestic violence?

What are some other resources you or someone you know have found helpful?

What can you do to be a resource for others?
