# **REVIEW CAREERS**



# ENGINEERING/TECHNICAL HEALTH SCIENCE/HUMAN SERVICES

Time Required: 30-45 minutes



# **Principles:**

• Students will acquire the skills to investigate the world of work in relation to knowledge of self and to make informed career decisions.

# **Objectives (Students will...)**:

 Use research and information resources to obtain information on a variety of careers.

GOAL: Students will share information about careers in the "Engineering/Technical" and the "Health Science/Human Services" clusters.

**Activity Statements**: Each student considering careers in these clusters will share detailed information about potential careers from information gained at <a href="https://www.nvcis.intocareer.org">www.nvcis.intocareer.org</a> or other reputable websites.

#### Materials:

Handout 1 – Outline for career presentation

Student reports, videos or websites

Programs of Study viewed in <a href="www.nvcis.intocareer.org">www.nvcis.intocareer.org</a> if a computer lab is available.

### **Procedures:**

Ask identified students (from last week) with an interest in these career clusters to share information with other students about their selected career.

# **Review Careers**

**Discussion:** Students will probably have their own questions, but here are some to get started.

- O Where can you find a job in this career?
- O Is there an opportunity for advancement?
- O Where can you go for training after high school?
- What kind of training is required? Apprenticeship, technical school, 2 or 4 year college?
- O What courses should you take in high school to prepare you for this career?
- Can you stay in Nevada if you choose this career?
