

ACT/SAT PREP Handout 1

Discussion Guidelines:

In small groups:

1. Each member of the small group state and discuss two features about the SAT OR ACT exam without repeating a feature.
2. Use Handout 2 to help with recall. Allow discussion to include similarities, differences, learning styles, college preferences, etc.

Divide students into groups of two or three:

1. Each individual determines which exam or exams would be advantageous for them to pursue and explain why. Include personal learning styles and preference of your target schools.
2. Discuss which test help aids interest you and seem most beneficial. Set up a time and place when you go online and browse national exam test sites.
3. Both the ACT and SAT require a testing fee. Discuss the benefits of registering during the regular deadline.
4. You have decided you want to take the ACT or SAT in the fall and you want to go online to check out your options. Briefly describe what you need to do & how you complete the process.
5. A reporter from each group shares key points from each test.
