

Time Required: 30-45 minutes

Content Standards: Students will complete school with the academic rigor and preparation essential to choose from a wide range of substantial post-secondary options, including college.

Indicators (Students will...): Students will discuss the current relationship between flexible career plans, postsecondary goals, five year high school course plans, report card, grades, standardized test scores, and academic improvement plans, and revise each as appropriate.
