COLLEGE RESEARCH II



Time Required: 30-45 minutes

Content Standards: Students will complete school with the academic rigor and preparation essential to choose from a wide range of substantial post-secondary options, including college.

Indicators (Students will...): Students will discuss the current relationship between flexible career plans, post-secondary goals, five year high school course plans, report card, grades, standardized test scores, and academic improvement plans, and revise each as appropriate.

GOAL: Students will continue to research post-secondary training options, research costs and ways to pay and begin narrowing options.

Activity Statements: Students will continue to research post-secondary training options, and discuss costs, ways to pay, and why or why not a school/training option is a good fit.

Students who are considering other training options may use forms from Lesson 12.9 to compare their qualifications to the post-secondary option they are choosing. If students are going into the military or an apprenticeship program, they need to research qualification criteria, educational training programs, costs and commitment involved and decide if this is a good fit for them.
