## 2009 High School Seniors:

- November 3, 2008
  - o The application for state level financial aid programs is available at <a href="www.wvapply.com">www.wvapply.com</a>.
- December 13, 2008
  - Last ACT test date to meet PROMISE eligibility. Scores will not be accepted for any tests taken after this date for students applying for a 2009 PROMISE award.
- January 1, 2009
  - The 2009-2010 FAFSA is available online at www.fafsa.ed.gov.
- January, 26 2009
  - Last SAT test date to meet PROMISE eligibility. Scores will not be accepted for any tests taken after this date for students applying for a 2009 PROMISE award.
- March 1, 2009
  - Students must complete the Application for State Level Financial Aid Programs online or submit a completed paper application to the PROMISE Scholarship Office.

    Applications submitted by mail must be postmarked by March 1, 2009. Students may use their eighth semester grades to achieve PROMISE eligibility (3.0 GPA in the core and overall), but must apply by March 1, 2009. Students may apply online at <a href="https://www.wvapply.com">www.wvapply.com</a> or by downloading a copy of the paper application at the same website.
