Turn left onto Broadway Ave.


Go 0.4 miles on Broadway Ave.

This 3-mile trail connects the University of Southern Indiana campus with Vanderburgh County's Burdette Park. The trail begins near the Discovery Center located in Burdette Park. It heads into the woods, then over hill and dell, crossing Broadway Avenue by the athletic fields and on to the USI Campus. Visitors will see all variety of flora and fauna, along with collegiate athletes in training and many people just walking their dogs. The scenery is breathtaking. Burdette Park is a government owned facility that provides a recreational and educational environment for patrons of all ages. The facilities include: BMX Racing, Chalets and Party Houses, Camping, Fishing Lakes, Miniature Golf Course, Tennis Courts, Swimming, Waterslides, Children's Spray Park, and Playgrounds.

What is a Volksmarch?
